Inflation will gradually continue, but may not be serious during 1960. The best investment policy during 1960 will continue to be a well-diversified portfolio with one-third in stocks for possible growth profits, one-third in bonds for safety and income, and one-third in cash in order to have funds available for investment in the severe and sudden drop in the stock market which will come some day.

CONCLUSION
The three handicaps to American business in 1960 will be increasing installment purchases, the unfair demands of labor union leaders, and President Eisenhower's physical condition. The three hopes for America are our churches, our schools, and our praying parents.

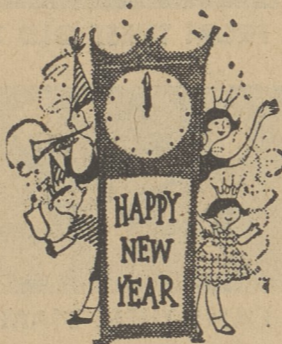
