"Reading is the most important The Department of Labor is one general method of learning. Thus, reading skills are essential to the learning of nearly every subject in educational process," Sister Celestine pointed out, adding that, "Reading Skill is often the key to successful high school and college

Since special instruction in reading is not always available in the school system, the Center will offer a reading course for the average student who wishes to become a better reader. This course is designed to increase reading speed and comprehension, along with the development of better study habits.

A second reading program, for the student who is having difficulty in school because of a reading disability, also will be offered. Each reading program will include diagnostic testing and individual instruction plans.

Another problem which often impedes the development of otherise able students is that of speech disability such as minor articulaion disorders. Under the Center's speech program, diagnosis and corrective training is offered for the child so handicapped.


