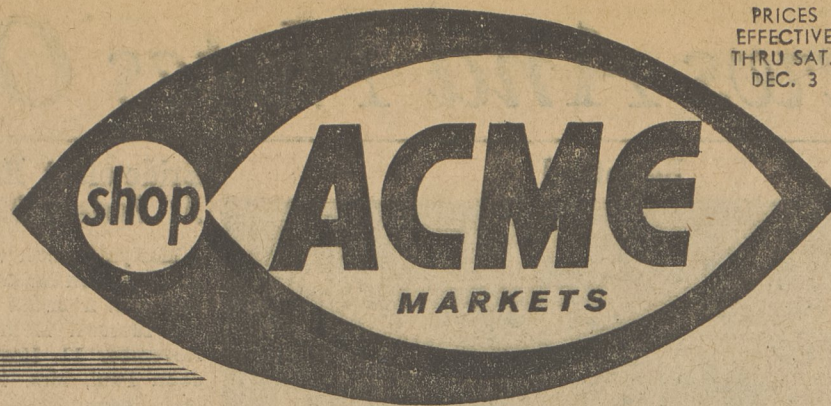

## Bob Coolbaugh Makes End On All Southern Conference Team

Robert Coolbaugh, former Dallas Township Football star, now a senior at the University of Richmond, has been named to an end position on the mythical All-Southern Football Team.

Bob, who broke all records this year on pass receptions and yardage

gained in the Southern Conference also broke his own record during Richmond's 19-0 victory over William and Mary College on Thanksgiving Day.

Bob led the Conference with thirty-five pass receptions. His near-

est competitors snagged fifteen apiece.

The All-Southern team was chosen in cooperative balloting among conference coaches, newspaper sports writers, and radio-TV sportscasters, wire services and the Southern Conference Sportswriters Association.

Commenting on his being named to the team, Bob said he attributed his success in football to the excellent coaching received at Dallas Township High School.

He has already received offers for tryouts next season with professional teams, the most recent was a phone call Sunday night to his home in Dallas from the San Francisco Forty-Niners.

In addition to his football honors, Bob is student commander of the college ROTC. He thinks he would like to follow a military career after a year or so in professional football.

While his dad and mother, Chief of Police and Mrs. Irwin Coolbaugh, are proud of his athletic and military record, they are pleased most with his scholastic achievement which has improved each year.

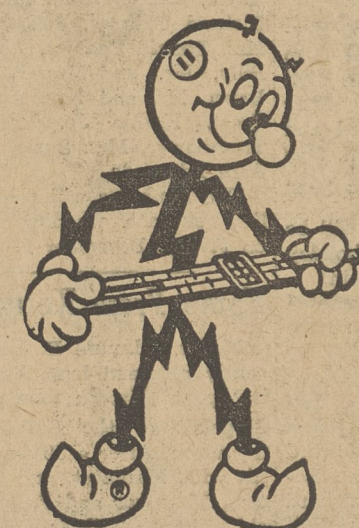

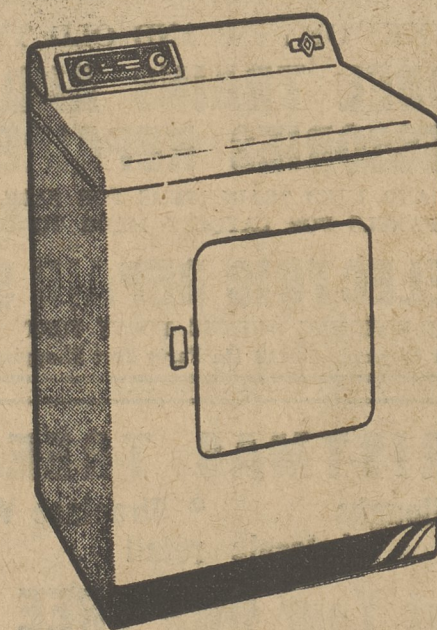
