Night School Classes Start

Business College Has Big Enrollment

Wilkes-Barre Business College Second Semester Night School Classes will begin Tuesday, January 17, at 6 p. m.

Students who have registered, as well as unregistered students will report at the same time to the 5th floor of Northeast National Bank Building on Public Square. Students have matriculated for diplomas in stenography, secretarial science, accounting, and business administration.

Among the individual subjects that will be taught are all phases of typing, beginning shorthand, advanced shorthand, "refresher" shorthand, business mathematics, business English, and office machines. Special typing classes for adults who have had no previous training will be offered Tuesday evening.

Francis V. Eustice, registrar, stated earlier in the year that registrations at the business college had reached an all-time peak in 1960, therefore, combining first semester students with those enrolling for second semester the Wilkes-Barre Business College will have one of the largest enrollments in its history.
