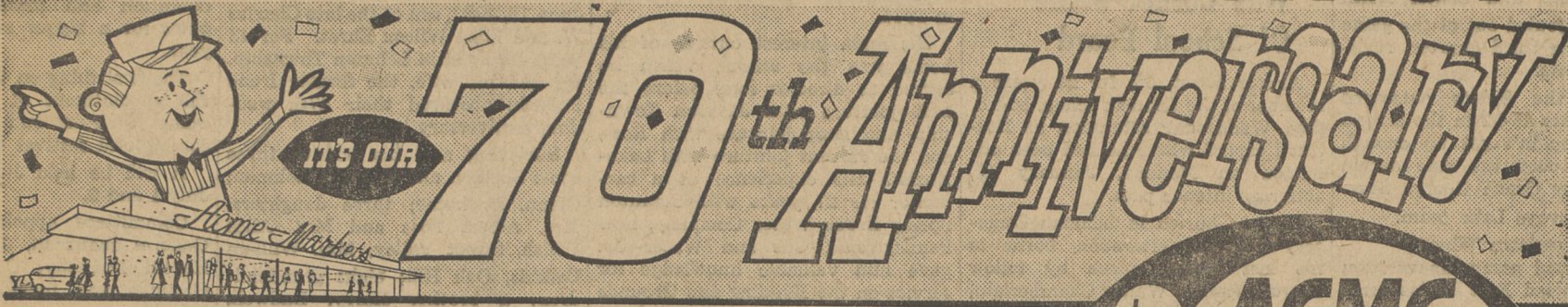

## Ashley Topples Lake-Lehman

All Five Starters Score In Double Figures

Ashley notched its fourth win in the North League with a 69-44 victory over Lake-Lehman Tuesday night. The contest was played on the Rockets home court.

Considering the won-lost record of the Knights, Lake-Lehman stayed fairly close until midway in the second period when the Rockets extended the margin to 10 points and by half-time led 29-15.

Lake-Lehman outscored the Rockets 15-13 in the third quarter to trail 42-30 going into the fourth period.

In the final stanza the Rockets turned on the steam to tally 27 points compared to 14 for the Knights.

Ashley's five starters all scored in double figures with Bob White leading the way with 21 counters.

For Lake-Lehman, Bob Rogers was the only bright spot scoring 19 tallies. Rodgers, a sophomore, has played outstanding ball in the last two games for the Knights along with scoring 33 tallies.

## Westmoreland Cops First Half By Downing Fairview 66-57 At Home

Gauntlett Sparks Champs With 22 Tallies; Trewern, Evans, Inman Score Double Figures

Westmoreland Mountaineers won first half honors in the North League Tuesday night by downing Fairview 66-57 on the Dallas Junior High floor before a capacity crowd. Westmoreland finished with a 7-0 record, while Swoyersville finished with 6-1.

Westmoreland will compete in Class A if they win the North League crown. Swoyersville or Ashley will compete in Class B whether they win the championship or not.

Fairview jumped off to a quick 4-0 lead on goals by Smith only to have Westmoreland come fighting back to lead 15-9 by the end of the quarter.

Gauntlett led the Mountaineers surge with 8 points on four goals from the outside.

Neither team showed a good shooting percentage in the period as Westmoreland hit but 5 of 17 shots and Fairview 4 of 17 attempts.

Both teams had a better percentage in the second period when the Mountaineers dropped 7 of 19 from the floor and Fairview 6 for 14.

Westmoreland extended its lead to twelve points by intermission as Evans tallied six points and Gauntlett and Inman five each to up the lead to 35-23 at half-time.

Sauerwine and Hudock each netted six points for Fairview in the period.

Westmoreland built up a lead of 16 points midway in the third stanza only to have Fairview slice the lead to 49-40 as the third period ended.

The visitors took advantage of some bad passing on the part of the Mountaineers during the final minute of the period and scored three fast buckets.

Smith with seven and Sauerwine six points in the period were responsible for Fairview's comeback.

Evans, Inman and Gauntlett all scored four tallies for the Mounts in the quarter.

Twenty Point Lead

Early in the final stanza Westmoreland reeled off eleven straight points to build up a 60-40 lead. Ronnie Trewern with six and Gauntlett four led the assault.

With this bulge coach Brobst inserted four new men and the ever scrappy Fairview five came roaring back again only to end up on the short end of a 66-57 score.

Vivian with six and Jeckell four led the comeback, but a little too late.

Tommy Gauntlett led all scorers with 22 counters and had plenty of help from Trewern with 14 and Evans and Inman with 13 each.

Smith paced the visitors with 17 followed by Hudock and Sauerwine with 11 each.

Ronnie Trewern turned in a tremendous game as he hauled in a countless number of rebounds.

Smith played a fine game for Fairview with his rebounding and scoring.
