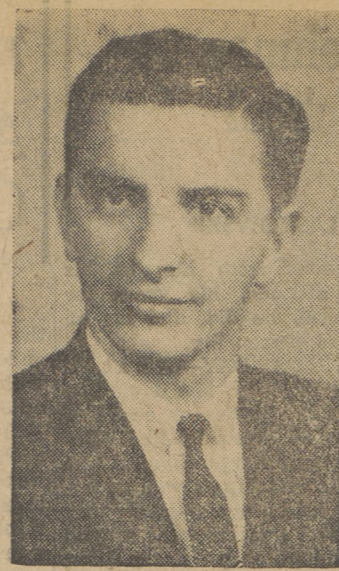
begins. Special services are scheduled for the churches, leading up to the solemnity of Good Friday observance and the joyousness of the Resurrection.

She was born in Cocheont, N.Y., daughter of the late Jacob and Caroline Hoelze Porr, and taught school in that area for a time after graduating from local schools. Upon marriage to Ray Warden, she moved to Pennsylvania. For 36 years the family lived in Shavertown. Mr. Warden taught mathematics at the GAR high school. Mrs. Warden was much interested in chemistry, studying it by correspondence, and maintaining a laboratory in her home. She was also interested in painting.

Surviving are three children: Mrs. D. E. Hardenbergh, State College; Mrs. Mae Johns, Laramie, Wyoming; and Claude, Shavertown; two sisters: Mrs. Walter Howell, Binghamton, N.Y.; Mrs. Roland Brown, Deposit, N.Y.; and seven grandchildren.
