After retirement, he enjoyed gardening, and kept up with his art work.

He had lived in Trucksville for 37 years, moving here from Kingston. His parents were the late John and Emma Heffner Owens.

Surviving are his widow, the former Beth James of Wilkes-Barre; a daughter, Mrs. Robert S. Stewart, Cincinnati, Ohio; a son, John, assistant cashier, First National Bank, Wilkes-Barre, at home; a brother, Arthur, Lancaster; two sisters, Mrs. Elizabeth Berger, Cressona; two grandchildren.
