State Stocks Game

Pennsylvania Game Commission Spring stocking program for the Northeast Division has been completed.

Rabbit trapping and transfer program has been increased and the number of rabbits trapped and released in the 13 northeast counties totals 8,178. These rabbits are trapped each year on Game Commission established rabbit farms, areas closed to hunting and cities and towns. The Spring stocking of ringnecks totals 4800, with 1910 cock birds and 1890 hens released.

Wild turkeys have been stocked in larger wooded areas, with 138 toms and 400 hens released in areas where they have established themselves.
