Beaumont hung up its second straight win in the Bi-County League Sunday with an easy 17-3 win over Forkston Men's Civic Club.

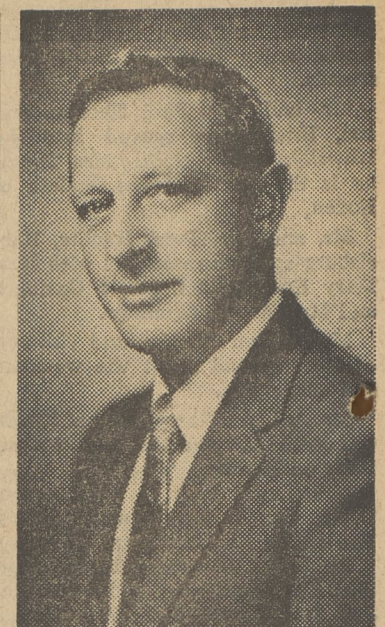
