

### Conyngham Gardens Only One In Area On Tour

The Conyngham Gardens at Hillside, are the only local beauty spots to be selected for the House and Gardens Tour, scheduled for today from 1:30 until 5 p.m.

The gardens were originated by W. L. Conyngham in 1882. A winding brook enhances the carefully tended lawns, shaded by fine old trees and colorful flowers, while lawns sweep steeply uphill to the house. Further up the hillside lies a wooded area, through which wild flowers bloom in the shady coolness. Hillside had the first swimming pool in the area. The original one, which was maintained for well over 50 years, was replaced by a modern pool some years ago.

The greenhouse was started in 1910, and added to from time to time. Howard Ide, Master of the greenhouse, has held this position since 1936. He is a recognized authority in his field.

The farm remains today under the ownership of the Conyngham family, and Mrs. William H. Conyngham maintains a summer home there.

The meeting was closed with a prayer for peace by acting chaplain, Frances Yankoski.

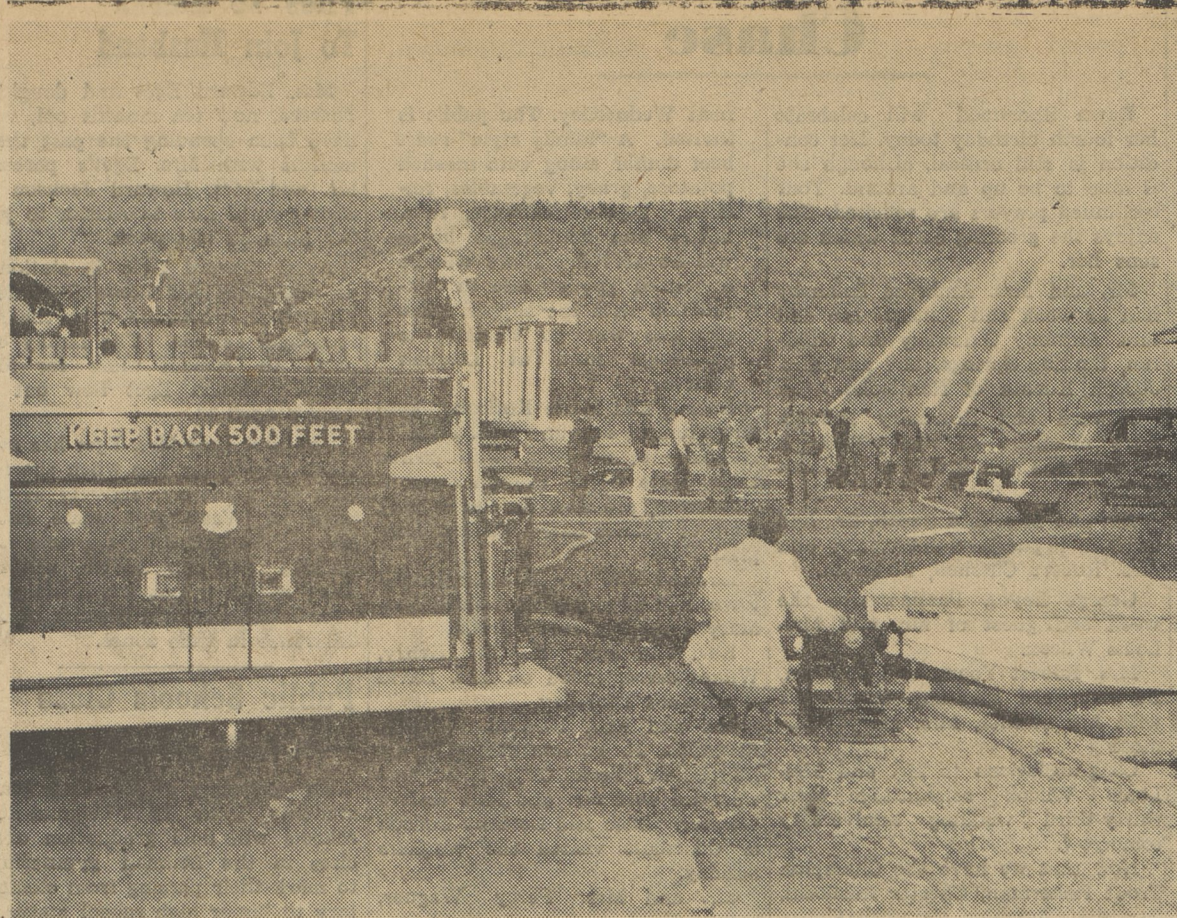
### Back In Lehman For Class Commencement

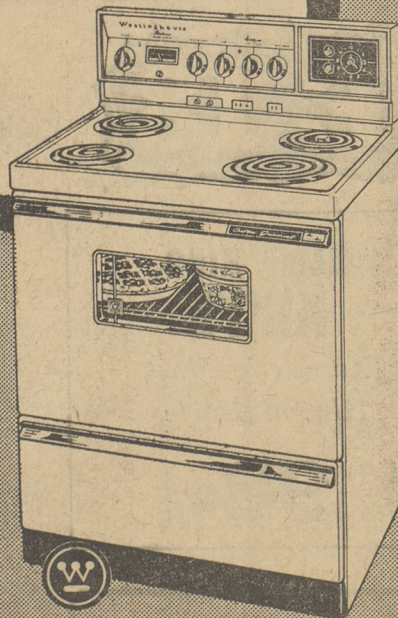

### Add Trim To Sweaters For Variety Ensemble

Trimming a sweater to go with a dress adds flair and beauty to the dress and usefulness and change to the sweater. Mrs. Ruth Darbie, extension home economist, Luzerne county, suggests using a classic cardigan with short or long sleeves, to complete the dress ensemble. She points out that the color of the cardigan may match or be in pleasing contrast to the dress color. Trim for sweaters may include embroidered, velvet, or grosgrain ribbons, braids, fringes, edgings and rickrack. You may wish to use lace, or make bands or simple applique from the dress fabric. But remember, simplicity is the key to a smart, fashionable costume.

Keep the use of the sweater in mind, advises Mrs. Darbie. For sports or casual occasions, use gros-

grain ribbon or simple appliques; for dressy occasions, trim with lace, embroidered ribbon, beads.

Preshrink any trimmings that will go on a washable sweater, then sew trimmings on the sweater with small hand stitches. Use thread that matches the sweater. If the trimming is heavy, you may need to put net backing on the inside of the sweater, or line it with a very lightweight fabric.
