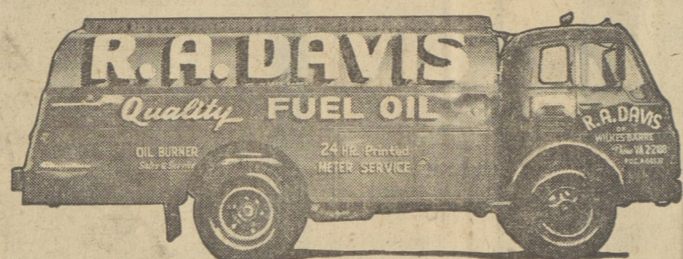

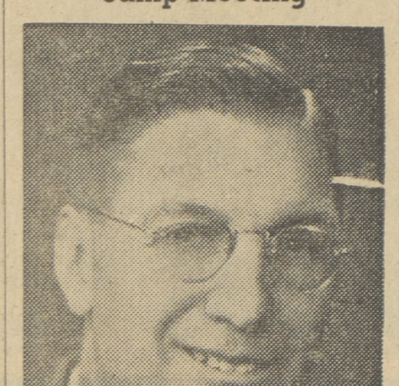

He describes it as "running around and replacing blown fuses," but Richard Demmy steered a 13 million job at Hunlock Creek to a successful conclusion two years ago...

He doesn't look like the popular conception of the Marines, either, but Dick was with the Marines during the occupation in Japan. That quiet twinkle might turn into something pretty disturbing.

As co-chairman of the Back Mountain Memorial Library Auction, Dick is getting the feel of the community. With four school-age children of their own, he and his wife, the former Ruth Groom of Poughkeepsie, N. Y., have a real stake in Dallas District Schools.

A 1942 graduate of Cornell University, with a degree in electrical engineering, Dick has had experience with the Scranton Electric Co., Hudson Coal Co. of Scranton as assistant electrical engineer, electrical engineer, electrical and mechanical engineer...

There was an interruption in September of 1942, after he had been a student engineer for Scranton Electric Co. In May of 1943, Dick joined the Army, serving as

field radio operator in both voice and code. In March, 1944, he joined the Marines, and was honorably discharged with rank of 1st Lieutenant in June of 1948.

Mr. Demmy is a registered Professional Engineer, member of Luzerne County Chapter of Pennsylvania Professional Engineers, belongs to American Institute of Electrical Engineers, and is chairman of the technical discussion group.

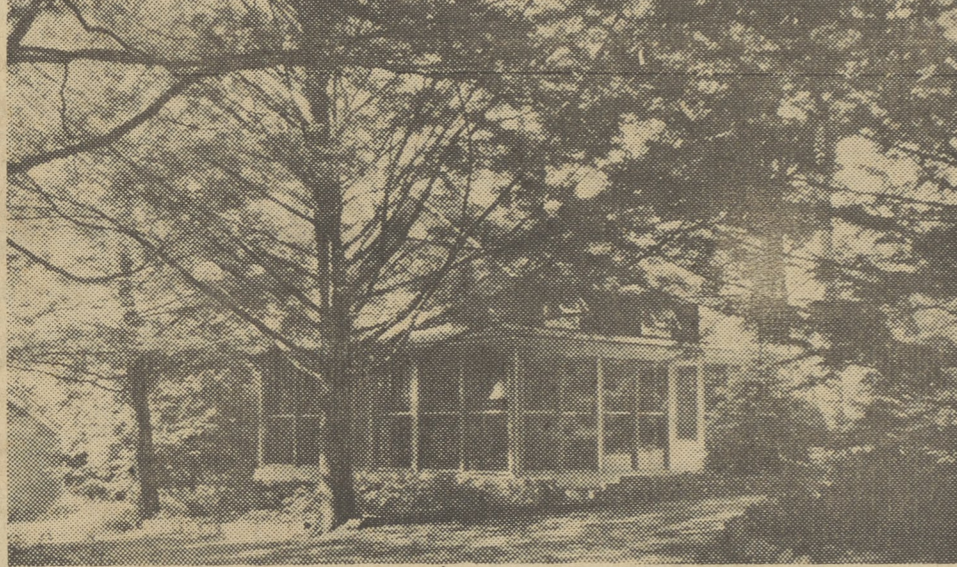
