

LITTLE LEAGUE NOTES
The biggest trouble with Little League ball to date according to

statistics out of National headquarters is the following—Too many parents are putting too much pressure on youngsters to star. A youngster is expected to pitch almost perfect ball; not make errors and get a hit every time he comes to the plate. Because of this pressure too many of these youngsters are inclined to mild forms of hysteria as a result of what they think is failure because of the demanding pressures of parents. Another factor hurting Little League ball is the fights between fans at these games. Parents are getting into fights and making examples of themselves which certainly are not symbolic of the type player we are hoping will be

developed by this type of competition. Many of the communities hard working and well meaning citizens are being berated by fans and parents who know very little about the rules of the game but think that anything that happens should happen for the benefit of the team on which their own youngsters play. Many of our officials at these games are well meaning, hard workers but the abuse they are subjected to is outrageous. Fans berate these people on any questionable call.
One of the local rules of Little League baseball which is being abused and ignored is the fact that fans are not allowed behind the backstop where they can yell at the

umpire or players. Some of our local people stand back in this area now and the abuse they hand out to umpires and players is disgraceful. One of the embarrassing parts of this rule is the fact that the manager of the team which is connected with the offender in anyway could find himself and his team losing the game. This sounds silly but that is the ethical part of this situation which the league saw fit to adopt.
