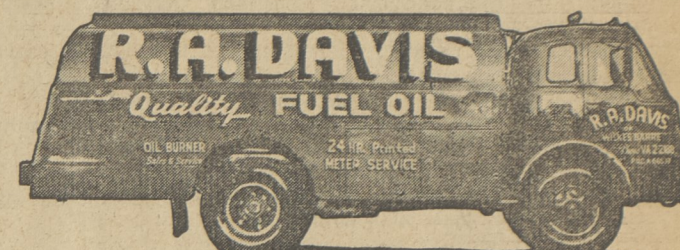

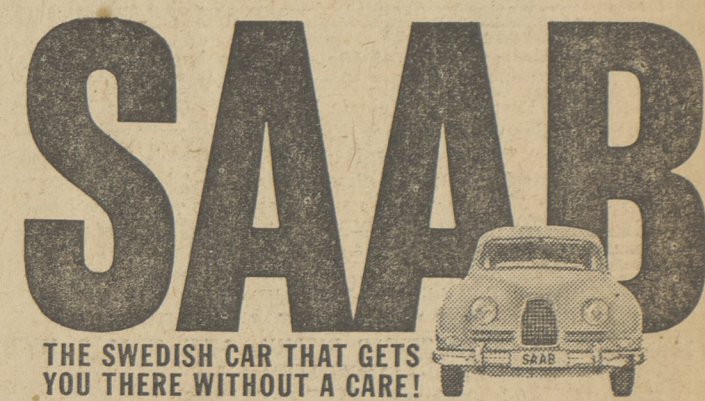

Motor Boats Banned From Most Park Lakes

Because of the rapidly growing popularity of boating on State Park lakes, the Department of Forests and Waters today issued new rules for boating safety for the State Parks to take effect initially only at Prince Gallitzin State Park in Cambria County and Gifford Pinchot State Park in York County.

Generally the new rules prohibit motor boats on any State Park lake with the exception of Prince Gallitzin, 18 miles northwest of Altoona; Pymatuning Reservoir in Crawford County; and at Presque Isle State Park on Lake Erie. Motors at Pymatuning and Prince Gallitzin are limited to six horsepower.

The Prince Gallitzin lake, which ranks as the second largest body of water entirely within the Commonwealth, was opened to boats with 6 horsepower on July 15.

At Presque Isle State Park on Lake Erie, and eventually at the Logan State Park site, near Philadelphia, the Department of Forests and Waters will develop substantial marina facilities for yachts and small craft.
