

Registration For Adult Extension Classes Set For Thursday, Friday

Registration for adult evening extension classes offered by Dallas School District is set for today and Friday at the Senior High School Cafeteria, 7 to 9 p.m.

Classes, subject to approval by the School Board September 12, are scheduled to open on Wednesday, October 4, and close on Monday, April 16, 1962.

Adults who did not complete their high school education may satisfy requirements for graduation.

Classes will meet on Mondays through Thursday 7 to 9:30 p.m. Classes scheduled:

Art 1 - Drawing (for beginners) composition, design, medium, char-

coal, pencil, pen and ink. Wednesday.

Art 11 - Water Color -- still life, landscape and figure. Tuesday.

Art 111 - Oil -- portrait, still life, landscape and figure. Monday.

(Changes may be made at discretion of the instructor).

Bookkeeping - A study of the principles; study of the ledger; preparation for financial statements; study of accounting terminology; completion of a practise set. Supplementary areas: Federal Income Tax, Life Insurance, Budgeting, Stock Market, and Investments. Tuesday and Thursday.

Consumer Economics - (Family

Finance) -- A study of Budgeting; Life, Fire, Auto and General Insurance; Investments and the Stock Market; Federal Income Tax Returns; Features of buying and renting a house; Financing purchases of automobiles, houses, and other household items; study of Wills and Estates. Wednesday.

Contemporary Political Science (1945 to 1960's -- 1945 - Organization of the United Nations - Truman Administration - Creation of NATO - Postwar Problems (domestic and international) - Korean War - Eisenhower Administration - Republican President's Policies (domestic and foreign) - Soviet Russia - Crises: Cuba, Congo, Laos, and economic recession at home - Presidential Campaign - Kennedy & Nixon - New Frontiers - New legislation - Projection of Kennedy Administration - "Free Democratic Government" ver-

sus "Communism" (This class will have guest speaker, and members may present modern problems for discussion. Tuesday)

Dramatics - Plays, make-up, scenery, etc. Monday

Driver Training - Back-of-the-wheel driver training at the convenience of the teacher and students.

Home Economics - Dressmaking courses in which the student is encouraged to work at her own speed on construction of garments for herself or family. Individual training is stressed, meeting needs of the advanced student as well as beginners.

Industrial Art - Making and finishing furniture: Woodworking 1 - Monday

Woodworking 11 - Thursday

Languages - Language courses will be offered to students from 7th to 12th grades as well as adults. Students must have an average of B or above in academic subjects, also approval of their principal and the guidance counselor.

Conversational Languages: German 1 - For Beginners - Monday; German 11 - Continuation of 1st years course. Tuesday; French 1 - For Beginners - Wednesday; Spanish 1 - For Beginners - Thursday.

Typing 11 - For those who wish to increase their speed and accuracy in typing. Monday and Thursday 8:15 to 9:30 p.m.

Classes will be scheduled if at least twenty persons enroll and the subject offered will be sponsored by the Board of School Directors.

Registration will be accepted for subjects not listed.

A single registration of \$5.00 will be required regardless of the number of subjects scheduled. The deposit will be returned at the last meeting of the class if the person has attended 75% or more of the scheduled classes. There will be a small tuition fee for non-residents of the Dallas School District.
