## Lake-Lehman Enrollment

Lehman figures at the end of the first day of school show an enrollment of 823 pupils in the grades, 780 in junior and senior high school a total of 1603, thirty-two over last year's end-of-year enrollment of 1571.

on the scene and took steps at once to open temporary banking offices in the vacant Frantz Card & Gift Shop directly opposite the burned out building on Memorial Highway.

Contents of safety deposit boxes and vault were found to be intact as soon as they had cooled sufficiently for inspection. Officers of Dallas Branch Miners National Bank responded while the building was still burning and offered all of their facilities to tide their neighbor over during the emergency and Back Mountain ready to serve its customers in its temporary quarters the following morning.

At the time of the fire new bank quarters were already under construction for Wyoming National in its adjacent building which will also house the new Shavertown Post-office. Construction has now been ordered full speed ahead and the manufacturer has been urged to speed the delivery of the new vault so that it may be in use by late October.

**Causes of Fire Unknown**  
Cause of the fire is not known and may never be determined. It apparently started in the rear basement where large supplies of paint were stored, rapidly spread up an open ramp to the first floor and then up a nearby stair well to the second floor. Flames were shooting from the rear second floor when firemen arrived. Loss to the Lumber Company was especially heavy at this time because large quantities of fall merchandise were arriving daily. Only two weeks ago \$10,000 worth of Christmas toys arrived and were stored in the building.

**Happy Incident**  
Commenting on the loss, Mr. Sowden said that it "will be heavy. Our insurance is a long way from covering it."
