

Lake-Lehman Upsets St. John's 27-12; Dallas Squeezes By Luzerne 2-0

Knights Defense Responsible For Victory; Blocked Punt By Dorosky Gives Dallas Safety

Action on the local grid scene the past weekend found Lake-Lehman upsetting a bigger St. John's eleven 27-12 and Dallas just managing to get by Luzerne 2-0 on a safety in the final minute of play.

LAKE-LEHMAN 27, ST. JOHN'S 12

Saturday was Parent's Day for the parents of the Lake-Lehman gridgers and the boys did things in a big way by upsetting a favored St. John's team 27-12 behind a hard-charging defense led by Bob Rincken and Barry Woodling.

Parents of the players were presented with gifts preceding the game and then proceeded to sit back

on a brisk, windy afternoon and see a rock-em, sock-em grid contest.

JOHNNIES TAKE LEAD

After an exchange of punts following the kick-off, Lake-Lehman fumbled on its own 8 with Maleski making the recovery for St. John's.

The Lake-Lehman defense rose to the occasion and stopped four running plays two yards short of the goal to regain possession.

On the first play the Knights fumbled the pigskin back to St. John's with Boyanoski, 275 lb. tackle making the recovery at the 2 to set up the first score.

On third down, Maleski cracked over from the one to give the Johnnies a 6-0 lead as a run for the extra point failed.

SMITH SCORES

On the exchange of punts early in the second period, Lake-Lehman got a break when Schwartz, kicking into a stiff wind had the ball blown back and with the aid of a good bounce took over on the 21.

With the big forward wall of St. John's still refusing to give much yardage, Lake-Lehman quarterback Rogers hit back Joe Smith at the 1 with a fourth down pass and he fought his way into the endzone. Ellsworth then booted the first of three placements to give the Knights a 7-6 lead.

RINCKEN RECOVERS FOR SCORE

Following the kick-off which Colarusso took on the goal and returned to the 8, St. John's picked up a first down at the 20 only to be set back half the distance of the goal for clipping, placing the

ball on the 10.

On the following play, Pisano attempting to pass was dropped for a 5-yard loss and on the next play Woodling hit one of the St. John's backs with a hard tackle, jarring the ball loose and Rincken recovered in the endzone for the touchdown. Ellsworth's kick was wide.

Ellsworth then got off another fine kick which the backs fumbled around near the goal before getting it back to the 5 where Ellsworth hurled the ball carrier down.

WALSH GOES 92 YARDS

Following a three-yard pick-up by Colarusso, Walsh took a hand-off and on a quick opener over tackle dashed 92 yards eluding several tackles until he broke into the clear at the 40.

Another run failed after the touchdown.

ELLSWORTH SCORES

On the fourth play of the third period, linebacker Stan Palmer crashed through to block an attempted punt and Kenny Ellsworth

scooped up the oval and raced 35 yards for the score. He then stepped back and booted the extra point for a 20-12 lead.

St. John's maintained possession of the ball for all but three plays in the third period.

They moved from the 19 to the 46 before a series of penalties moved the ball back to the 32 where another fumble occurred and Karl Squier recovered for Lake-Lehman.

Maleski erased another threat by the Knights by intercepting a pass on his 7-yard line.

SQUIER BLOCKS PUNT, SCORES

Failing to pickup a first down as it reached the 13, St. John's was forced to punt on the first play of the final period and sophomore tackle Karl Squier broke through to block another Johnnies punt and recovered in the endzone for the score. Ellsworth then booted the extra point to wind up the scoring for the day.

St. John's moved from the 15 to the Lake-Lehman 37 behind the running and passing of Walsh before another series of penalties pushed them back to their 39 from where Joyce got off a booming punt with the wind in his favor and the ball was downed on the one-foot line by one of the Johnnies linemen.

Kicking into a strong wind, Ellsworth then booted the 30 shortly before the game ended.

FANFARE

Despite the size of the St. John's line, Lake-Lehman consistently out-rushed them on defense after the opening period.

The entire defensive alignment of Eddie Edwards played heads up football with Rincken, Woodling, Ellsworth and Brown doing most of the standout work.

"Big Boy" Pete Boyanoski was a standout most of the afternoon for the Johnnies as he refused to give up much yardage in his vicinity.

Walsh was the offensive standout on the field for both clubs.

St. John's led in first downs six to two.

DALLAS 2, LUZERNE 0

A fired up Luzerne eleven battled Dallas to almost a standstill until the final period when Dallas moved from its own 30 to the Luzerne goal line before being stopped.

In the opening period Dallas reached the Luzerne 9 but the defense stiffened and Luzerne took over on downs.

In the second period the Lions put in two bids for scores but the Dallas defense dug in and stopped them at the 8 and then the 15.

MISSES FIELD GOAL

In the third period Luzerne marched to the Dallas 21 from where halfback Tom Yezelski missed a field goal attempt from the 27 that went wide.

PENALTY NULLIFIES SCORE

In the final period the Dallas offense really came to life as it

moved from the Dallas 30 to the one-foot line before being stopped.

After reaching the 10, Farley moved to the Luzerne goal line from where on third down Dorosky crashed over for the score only to have it nullified as coach Brominski made an illegal substitution and had 12 men on the field.

Playing the ball back to the five Dallas moved to the 1 from where Dorosky was stopped a foot short on a fourth down running play.

BLOCKS KICK

Luzerne elected to punt out of danger with less than a minute remaining on third down only to have linebacker Tommy Dorosky crash through and block the punt with the ball going out of the endzone for a safety and a 2-0 victory.

Hislop, Harris, Dorosky and Farley did most of the gaining for Dallas while Oatridge and Yezelski were the big guns for Luzerne.
