Income Tax Returns

Be sure to list your social security numbers on your 1961 Federal income tax returns. Both husband and wife should list their numbers on a joint return.

This word of caution from R. P. Brownell, District Director of the U.S. Internal Revenue Service, Scranton District, who also reminds taxpayers that April 16 is the deadline this year for filing their returns.

Some returns are being filed on which one or both social security numbers are omitted, the IRS representative said. Along with checking other entries on the return, taxpayers should double check to make sure that social security numbers are complete and accurate.

When overpayment of social security taxes occurs, because of working at more than one job, space is provided on the return for a credit of the overpayment to any income tax owed, or to any refund due.
