## Jackson Fire Association Has Its Fourteenth Annual Dinner

Jackson Township Firemen's Association held its fourteenth annual dinner at the Fire Hall Saturday night with more than 100 persons in attendance.

School Director, Charles Frantz, was toastmaster. Carl Aston, president, introduced officers of the Association: Louis T. Wilcox, vice president, Wesley Lamoreaux, secretary and Albert Sherman, treasurer.

President Aston also introduced Mrs. Roland Gensel, president of the Auxiliary, who in turn introduced members of her cabinet: Mrs. Evelyn Wilcox, vice president, Mrs. Amelia Yanchik, secretary and Mrs. Pendric Rice, treasurer.

President Aston acknowledged and thanked the Auxiliary for their help to the Association over the years. He then introduced the Trustees: Fred Fielding, Harold Bertram, Fred Gabel, Albert Sherman and Walter Coolbaugh; representative to the Firemen's Relief Association, Mr. Paul Snyder; and representative to the Back Mountain Firemen's Association, Robert Cooper, who was not present, due to illness; Fire Chief Roland Gensel, Asst. Fire Chiefs, Harold Bertram

and Robert Cooper. President Aston asked that every Township resident to check for and eliminate all fire hazards in their homes.

President Aston said the Association has purchased oxygen equipment for rescue work at fires and also for emergency use in case of heart attacks. It is available to anyone in the Township by calling the Fire House.

The Association also purchased helmets for the firemen and a 1000 gallon capacity tank truck which gives added protection to citizens.

Toastmaster Frantz, then called on Norman Thomas, humorist, who entertained with funny stories.
