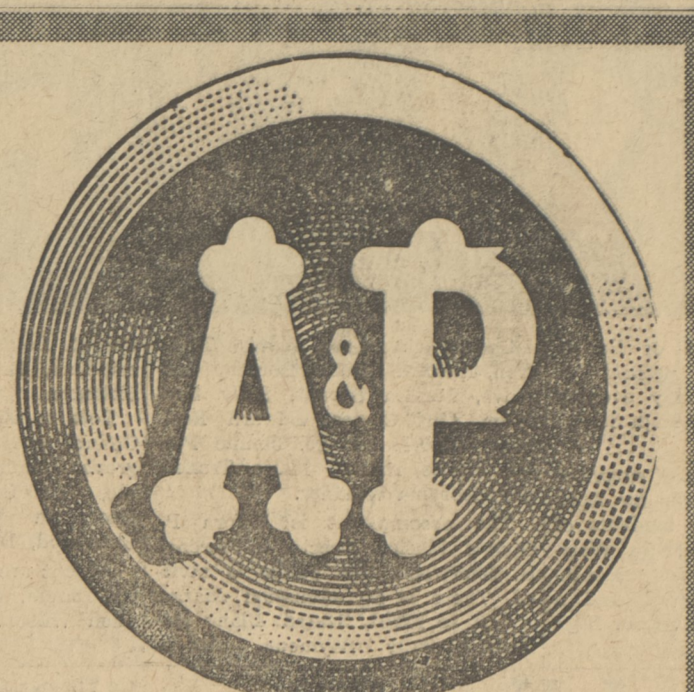
Robert E. VanHorn To Talk To Book Club
