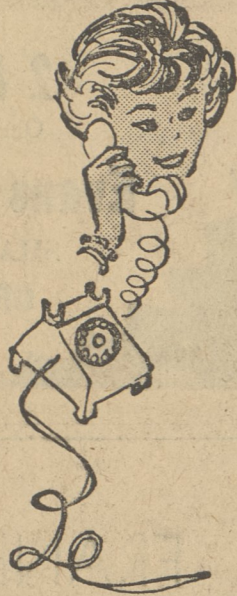
Nancy Hess To Study On Fellowship Grant

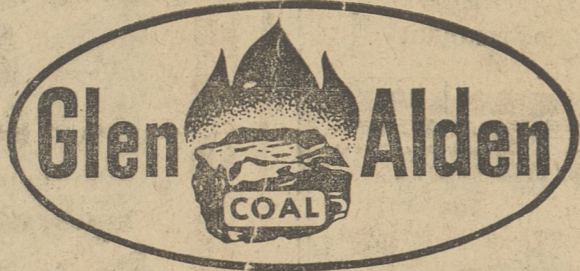

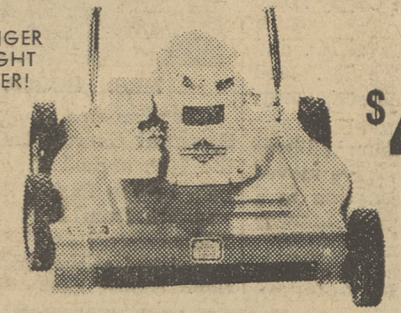
