### Check The Brake

For safety's sake yours and the other fellow's have your car's brakes checked periodically and adjusted to perform properly, advises Keystone Automobile Club.

Many drivers do not realize how great a strain is placed upon automobile brakes by the recurrent need for stopping the motion of several thousand pounds of metal and machinery smoothly and quickly, says Edward P. Curran, Keystone's Safety Director.

"That strain and the resulting friction produce constant wear on brake linings and drums", he warns, "and the first indication of brake trouble should be looked into immediately by a competent auto mechanic. In fact, those early signs of trouble probably could be avoided, too, through fairly fre-

quent check-ups even though the brakes seem to be functioning perfectly."

The Keystone official listed the following common symptoms of brake trouble:

1. A sudden release or dropping of the brake pedal when foot pressure is applied.
  2. Pedal squeaks.
  3. Squealing of brakes during quick stops.
  4. Swerving and off-line stopping.
- He also gave the following advice on preventing undue wear of brakes:
1. Go into low gear while descending steep grades.
  2. Start applying brakes before beginning a curve.
  3. Slow car down gradually when coming to a stop.
  4. Do not drive through sand or fairly deep water unless absolutely necessary.
  5. Do not "ride" the brake pedal.

6. Have the brake fluid checked regularly in the master cylinder.

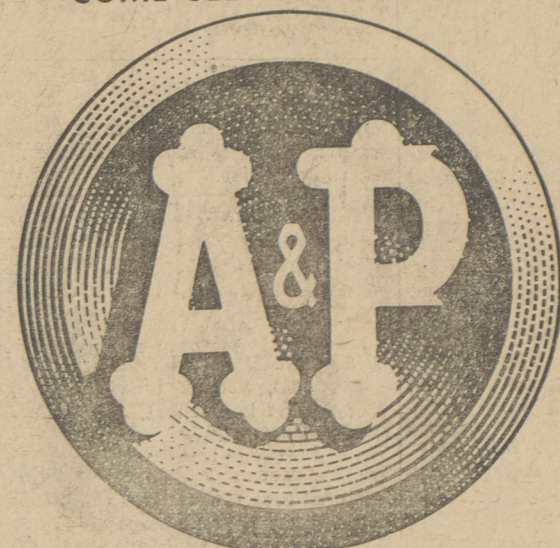
