Waverly Antique Show Scheduled September 10th

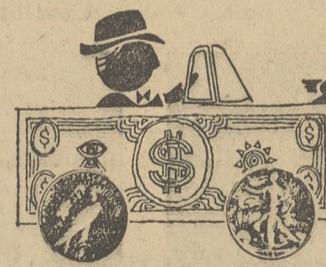
