Three local men received graduate degrees from Pennsylvania State University at commencement exercises at University Park Saturday.

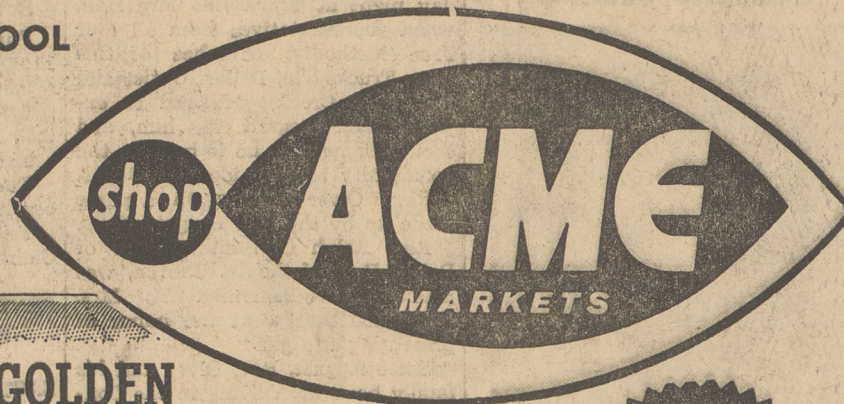

James C. Goodwin, 124 Harris Hill Road, Trucksville, was conferred a Master of Education degree in History.

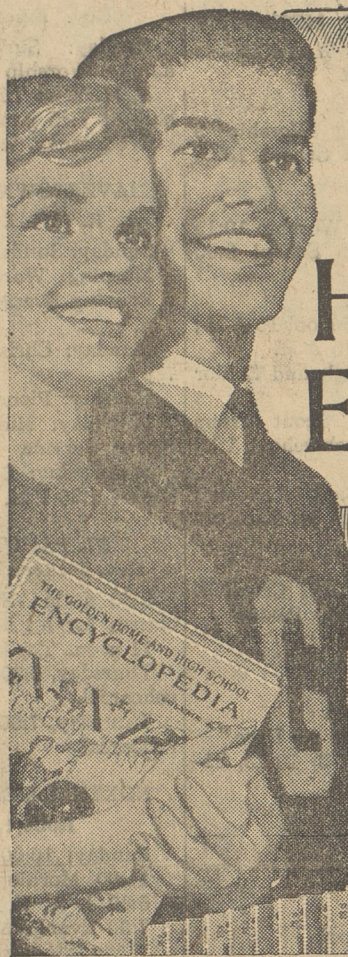
The awarding of 816 degrees, 403 of which were advanced degrees, marked the end of the Summer Term at the university.
