And far from being depressed by her physical helplessness, she was the port in a storm for many friends who needed encouragement or a word of advice.

She was born in Kunkle, daughter of the late William Thompson and Adelaide Ryman Austin. She was educated at Monroe Township Schools. Two brothers have been school supervisors, William A.
