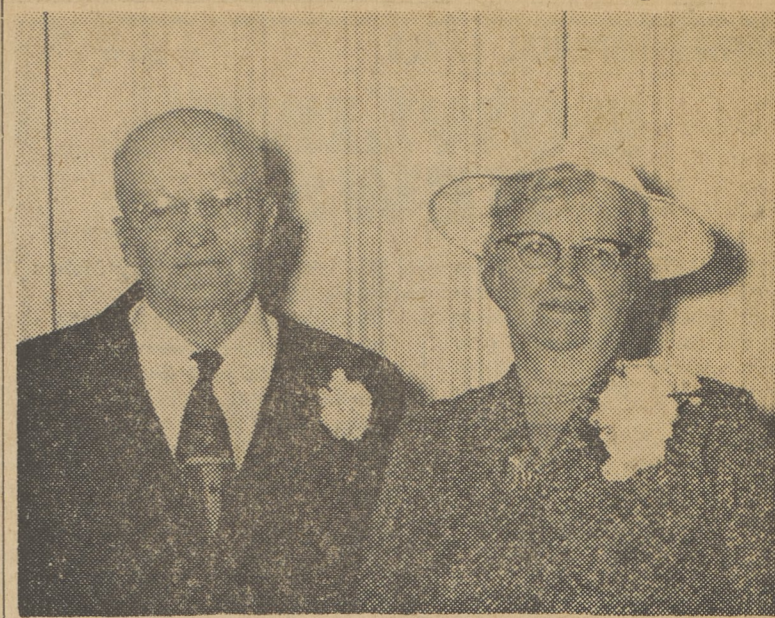
Drake Twins Have Eighth Birthday Party

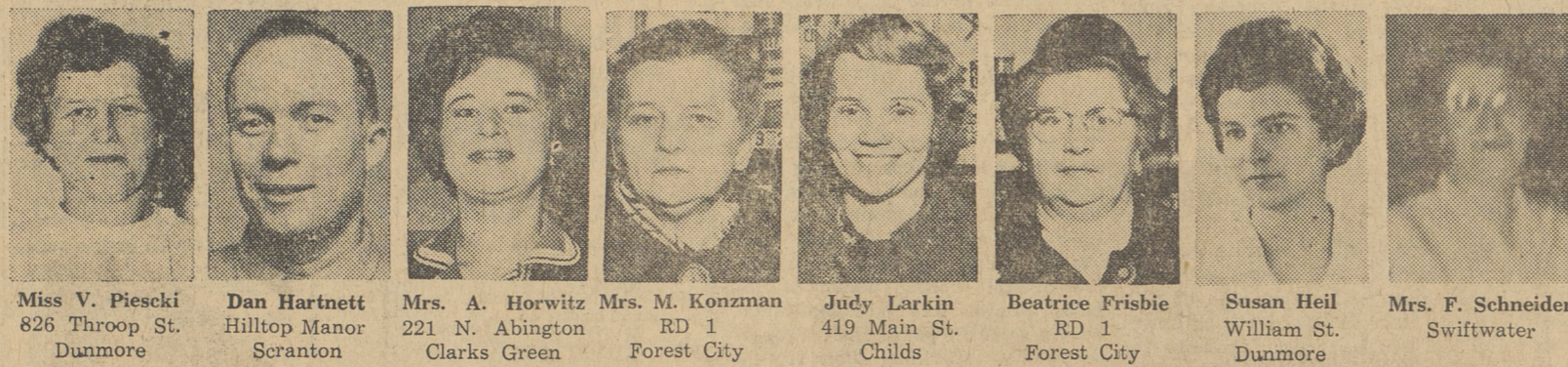
