

Brave Young Mother Battles Illness

A courageous young mother who had battled fatal illness for two years, died Thursday afternoon at her home in Shavertown, leaving a six-year old daughter.

Mrs. June E. King, 30, was born in Wilkes-Barre, daughter of Florence Hess Stevens and the late Clyde Stevens. A 1950 graduate of Coughlin High School, she was employed, before onset of illness, by the Chocolate Popcorn Co. of Kingston, and later by the Acme Market in Shavertown.

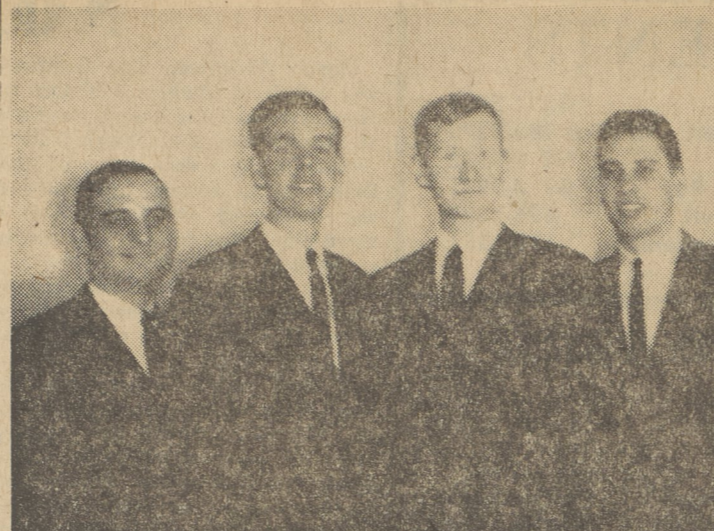

Four Elders At Mormon Church Work Expands In Back Mountain

Four ministers from the Church of Christ of Latter Day Saints have been assigned to this area to organize a youth activities program. Joining Elders Eldon Quinn from Las Vegas and Jack A. Weyland from Billings, Montana, both of whom have been in this area for some time, are Elders A. Reed Gibby, from Los Angeles, and Dennis Chapman from Mesa, Arizona.

It is not generally known that the Mormon Church sponsors the largest basketball and softball league in the world, involving over 10,000 young men, and that it was the first religious organization to sponsor the Boy Scout movement.

The four young elders are part of a group of over 12,000 who voluntarily donate two years of their youth at their own expense to furthering their mother church, returning to college or secular pursuits after their time of "laboring" in the field is completed.

Elder Gibbs, laboring at Brown's Mills, N.J., before coming to Trucksville, had attended Ventura College in California, majoring in civil engineering. Elder Chapman, coming here from Albany, has completed one year at Brigham Young University, majoring in political science. Elder Quinn, in Trucksville for the past three months, majored in speech therapy at Idaho State College. Elder Weyland, joining Elder Quinn a few weeks ago from Long Island, holds a bachelor of physics degree from Montana State College.
