ORDINANCE NO. 1
AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DALLAS, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA fixing the tax rate for the fiscal year 1963.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Dallas, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1963, as follows:

Tax rate for general Borough purposes, the sum of (15) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

For debt purposes the sum of (3 1/2) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

For other purposes as follows: Light, Water and Fire, the sum of (3 1/2) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

Making a total tax rate for all Borough purposes of twenty-two (22) mills.

SECTION 2. That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. 2
AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DALLAS, LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, levying a per capita tax of five dollars for the calendar year 1963.
