**Stress Need For Research In Oak-Wilt**

Continued research on oak wilt, together with the current survey and control programs, was stressed at the recent annual Tri-State Oak Wilt Conference held at Mont Chau Lodge, near Morgantown, W. Va.

Pathologists and control workers representing Pennsylvania, West Virginia, Maryland, Virginia, Kentucky, and the United States Forest Service discussed various phases of the oak wilt problem. A slight decrease in the total amount of the disease located and treated during the 1962 season was reported by the represented states. Increased efficiency in the organizations. **Stress Need For Research In Oak-Wilt**

Research representatives of Pennsylvania State University reported on the extensive work being done in connection with the disease on Chestnut oak. The possibility of this species being connected with spread of the disease to trees of the Red and Black oak group had serious consideration.

Research workers from West Virginia University reported on the favorable results obtained from the deep girdle method of treating diseased trees to prevent spore, the formation that is responsible for long distance spread of the disease.

Both groups of research workers outlined proposed studies for the coming season that are designed to reveal new data concerning physiological aspects of the disease and its spread. These would concern temperature, humidity, wind and weather conditions. Other work related to root grafting as a method of local spread was reported, as well

as work in connection with the possible insect vectors of the disease. Federal Forest Service workers reported on the results of a five-year study by comparing control methods used in the various states. Although the study is not complete, results to date indicate that the Pennsylvania control method administered by the State Department of Agriculture is giving favorable results as compared with check areas where no control is used.

A report on the work being done by the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture was presented by A. R. Jeffery, of the Bureau of Plant Industry.

Reports were given also on several other serious forest diseases on which considerable research is currently being done. These include maple canker, a serious disease of Sugar maple, and Phomes annosus, a disease that is doing damage to coniferous plantations.
