Vance Johnson, Providence, R. I. was also a house guest.

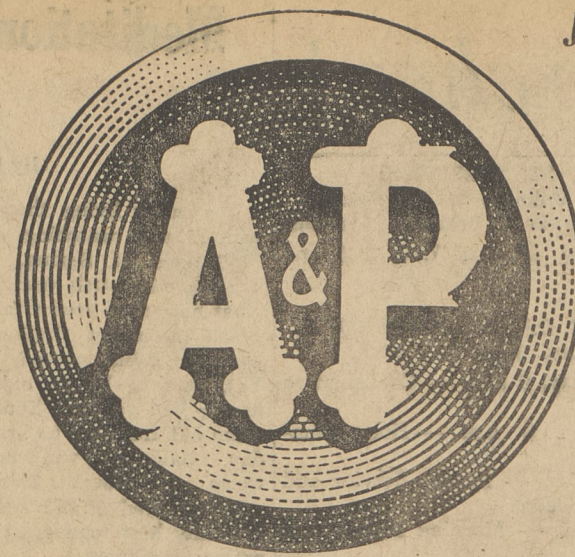
Mr. and Mrs. Clayton Williams and family and Mrs. Katherine Johnson, Towanda, also dropped by for the gathering.
