Trexler, Northeast Division Supervisor, Pennsylvania Game Commission, reports that over 920,000 food and cover producing seedlings were distributed in the Northeast Division during the past week to Sportsmen's Clubs, Farm Game Project Corporators, Boy and Girl Scout Troops, and other interested organizations. Large numbers will also be planted on State Game Lands in various counties.

Cooperating groups sign an agreement which stipulates that the seedlings will be planted on land open to public hunting, and also to show the location where the seedlings will be planted.

In some areas multiflora rose hedges will be planted to provide escape cover along field borders; in others, species such as Asiatic Crabapple or Bittersweet to provide both

Home Economist To Open Spring Furniture Show

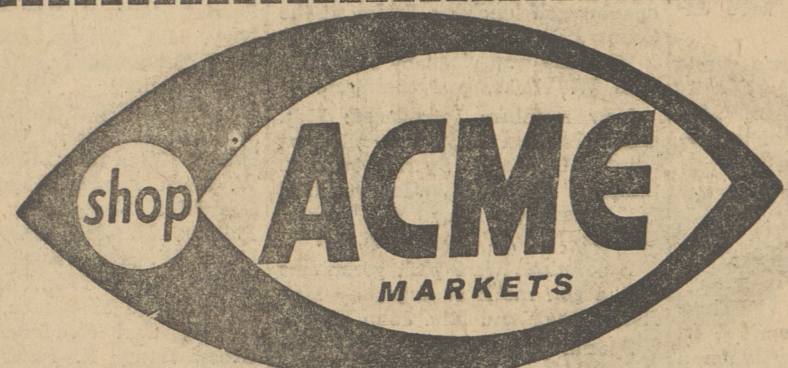
