Nanticoke representatives placed second in attendance.

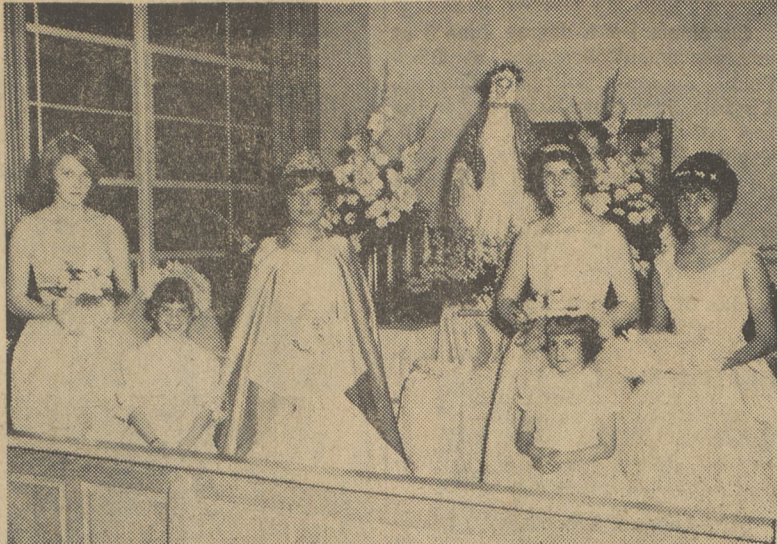
Rev. Harry Strauss, guest speaker, stated that 75% of modern delinquency problems should be laid to parents, who have failed to perform their God given duty to their offspring.
