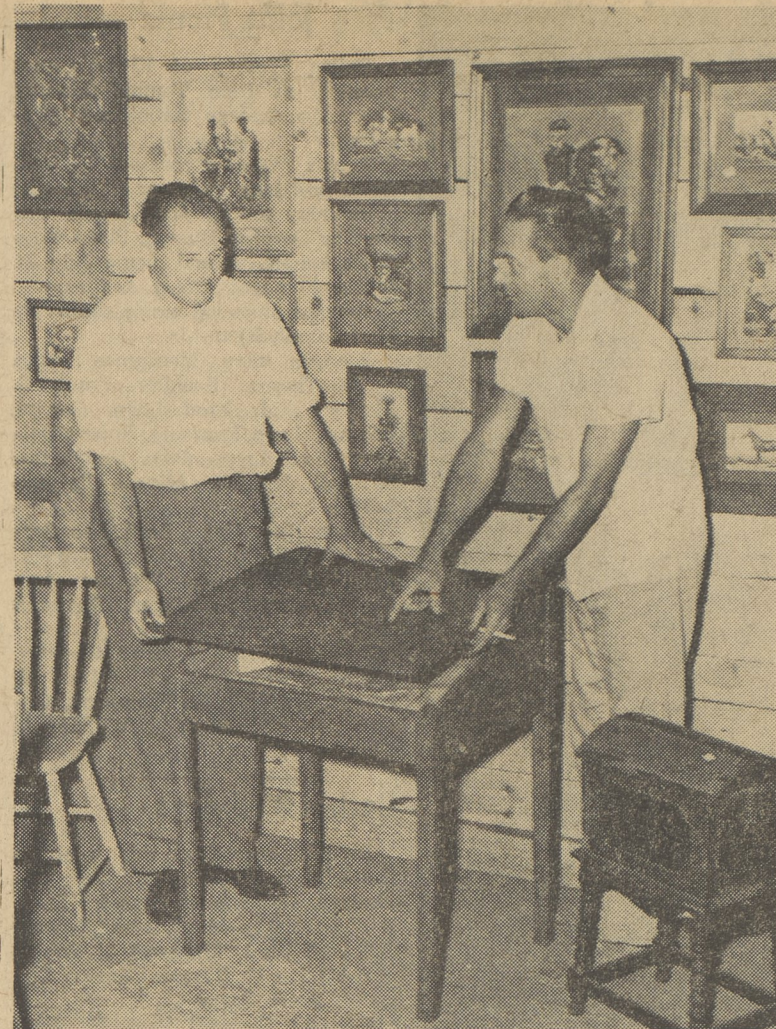

## Lightning Season

The season for sudden storms with thunder and lightning is here. Certain safety rules will help. Out here in the country, there are few steel-framed buildings to insure safety, but there are other places almost equally safe.

Interiors of automobiles offer good protection, but beware when getting in or out. A car's rubber tires prevent grounding, but a man touching a door handle makes an excellent conductor.

About the worst place to be during a storm is under a tree. People are better conductors than wood and a bolt hitting a tree branch will often flash through to the man beneath it.

Golfers and others caught in the open by a sudden lightning attack will be safer lying on the ground, preferably in a depression, than standing. Golfers also should waste no time getting clear of metal-shafted clubs. While lone trees are dangerous, dense woods make fair shelter.

Swimmers are among lightning's favorite targets because a strike on water endangers everybody in the immediate vicinity. Boats with masts should have lightning rods leading directly to the water.

Don't worry about the thunder. If you hear it, the lightning missed you.

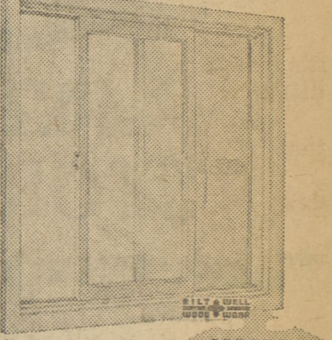
