**Local Teachers Attend Meeting**

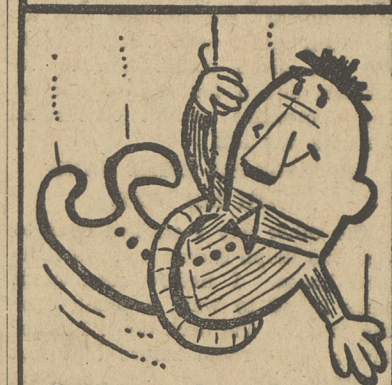
