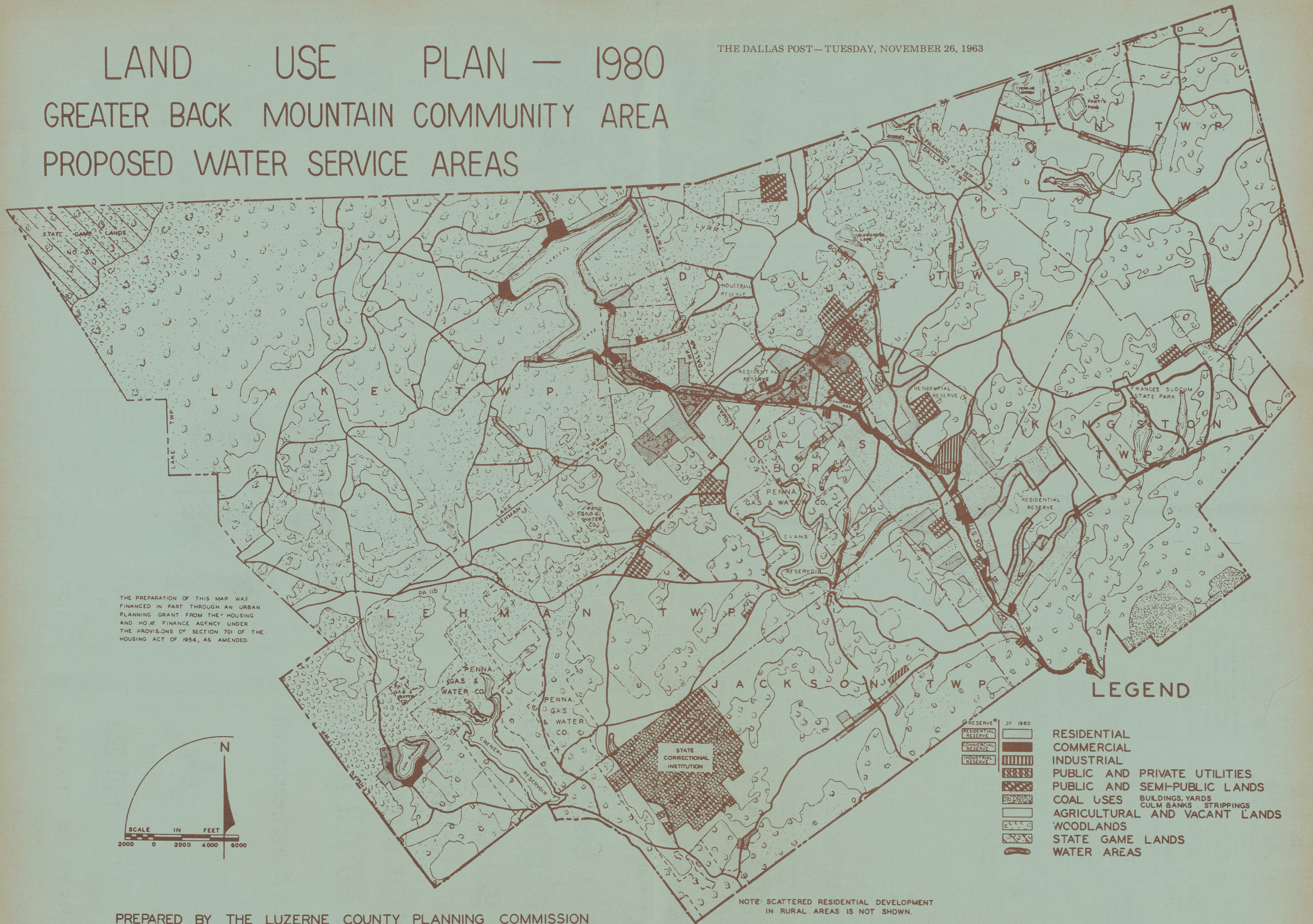


LAND USE PLAN — 1980

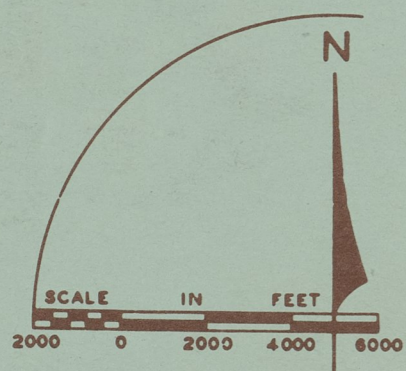
GREATER BACK MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY AREA
