Trucksville Free Methodist Church is praying and working for a miracle in the month of December.

Continually rising prices have pushed the completed costs of the building to about \$7,500 more than available funds. Therefore, the congregation is going all out to work to raise that \$7,500 during the month of December.

Even the children are enthusiastic. Each child has been given a picture of the new church to remind him to pray daily for the miracle month. Parents have been asked to make it a special matter of prayer in the home, and a group meets on Saturday nights for additional prayer. The children eagerly agreed to give up their treat at the Christmas program and instead of receiving candy, they all want to bring a birthday offering for Jesus to help with the new church.

The first Sunday of December saw contributions totalling \$651 for the new church from the 103 persons jammed into the small sanctuary of the old church at 30 Carverton Road. The task seemed so impossible to the small congregation that until it actually began to materialize in the form of wood and stone it seemed beyond belief. It is hoped that it will be completed by early February.

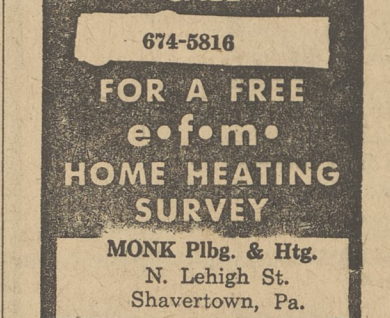
