DALLAS Junior High NEWS

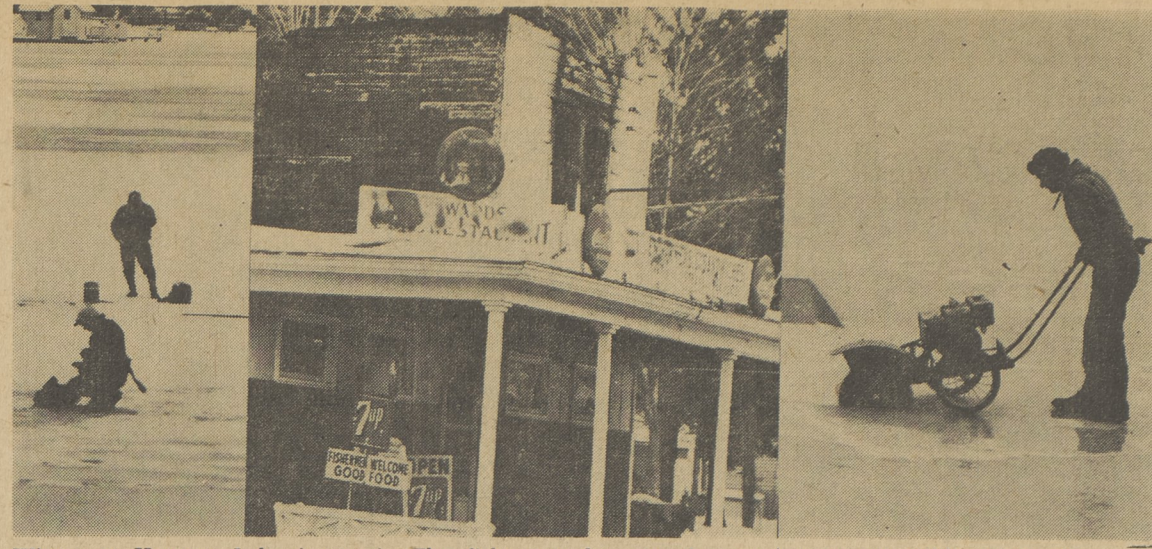
Now that vacation is over everyone is really working hard. Our mid-year exams are coming up in a few short weeks.
