Jean Updyke, Trucksville; Helen Booker, Dallas, and Edward Mushinski, Hunlock Creek, have been selected for the week of May 11.

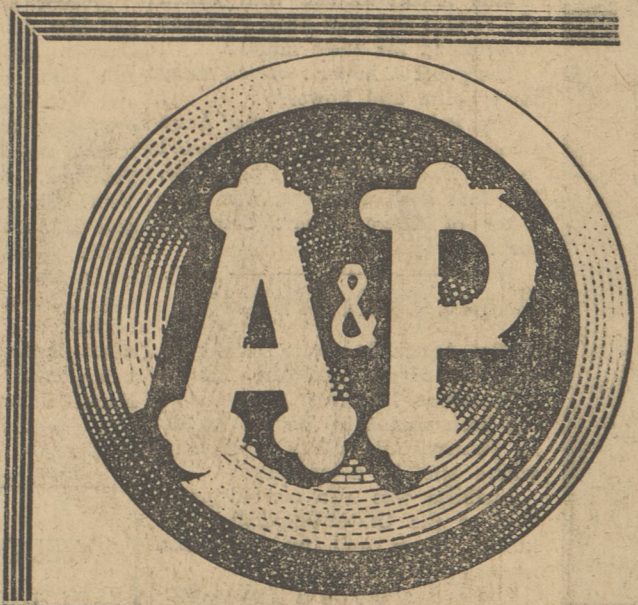
Mrs. Della Case, Lehman Township, and Evelyn Stephanski, Hunlock Creek, have been drawn for duty the week of May 18.

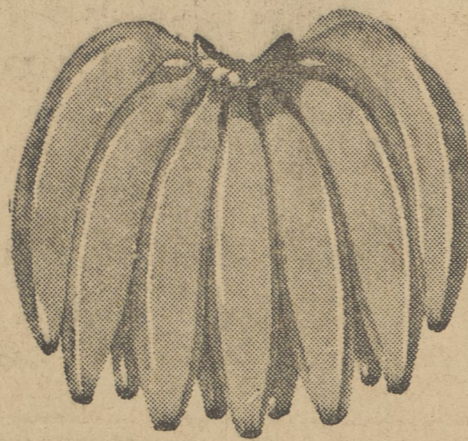
