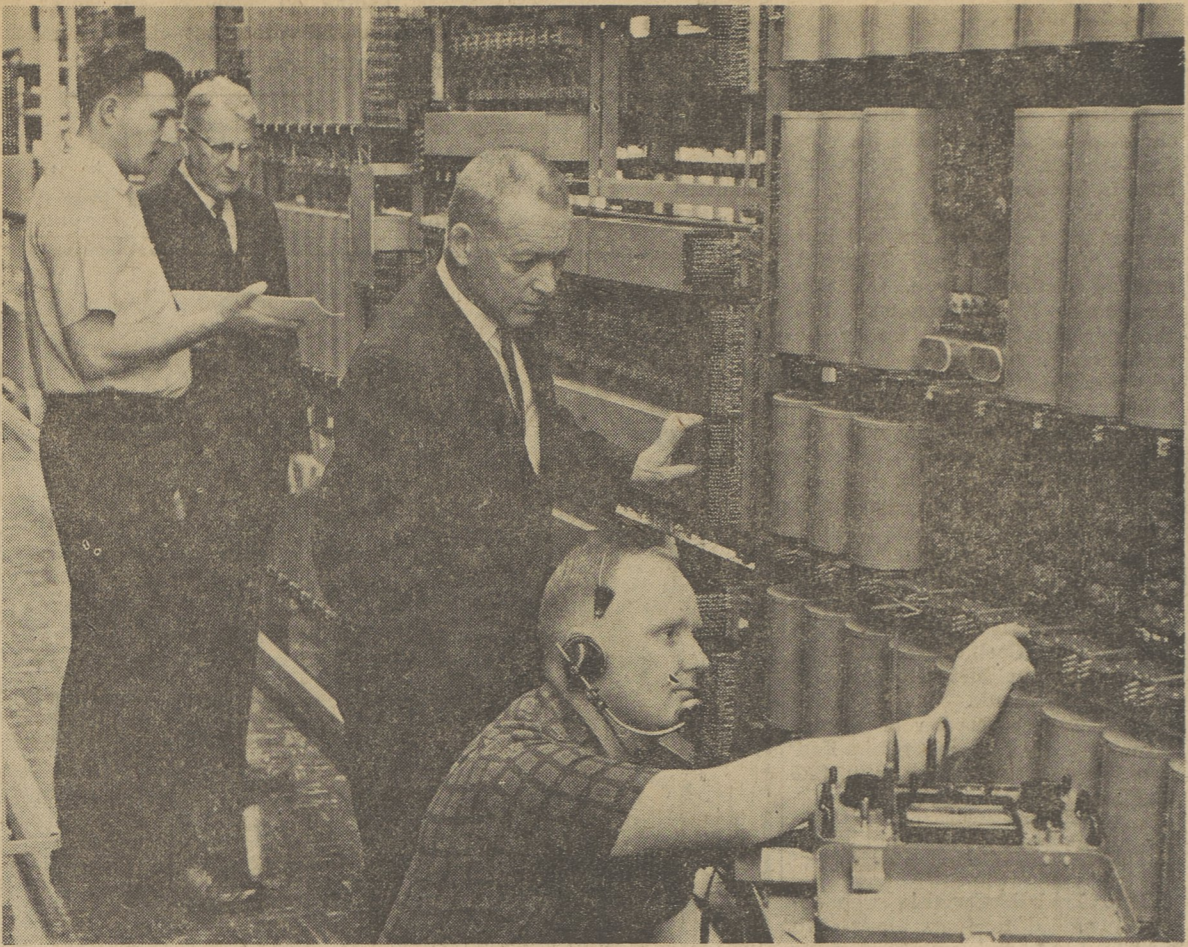


Checking Equipment For New Toll-Free Calling
