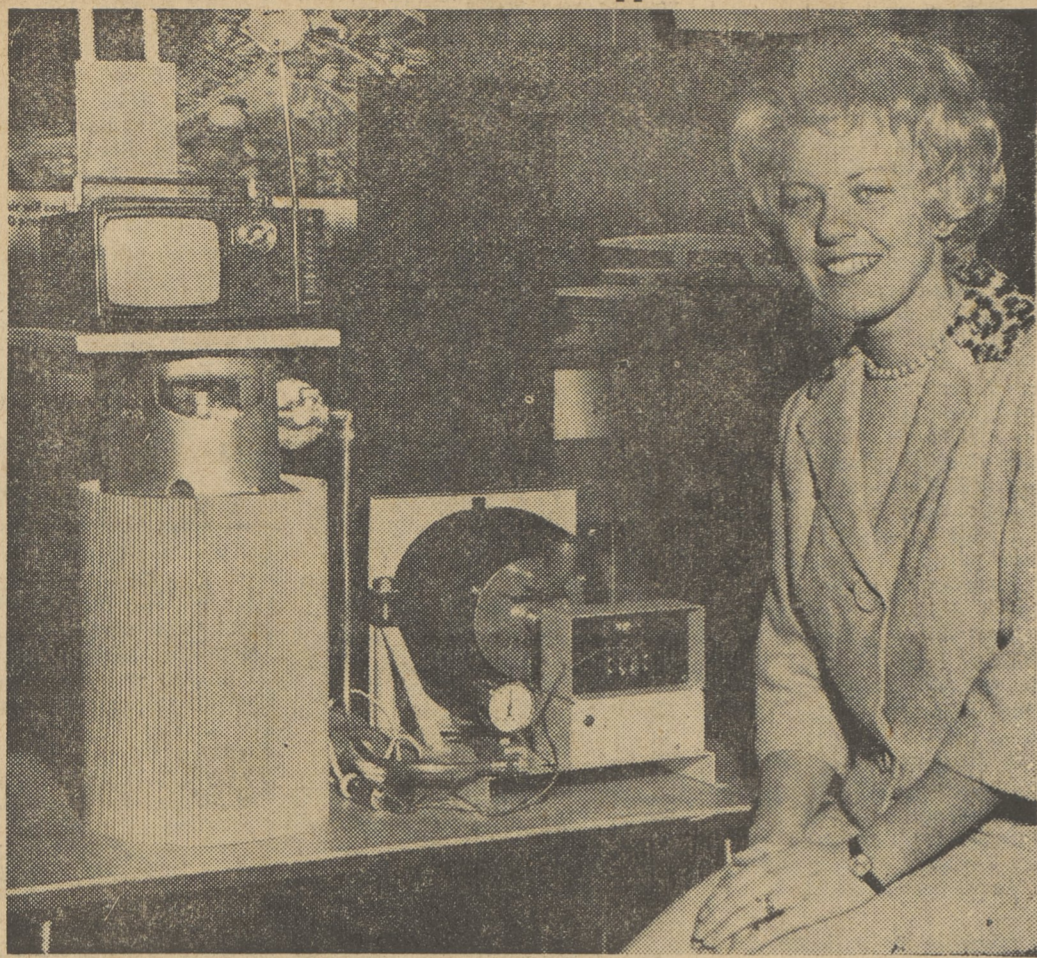


New Gas Powered Television Supplies Innovation

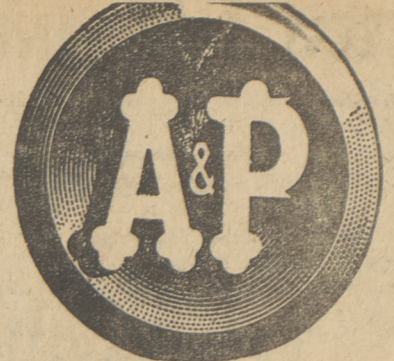
