Debby told of her work with Teri during the year. She also brought her grooming box and explained the use of each object in it.

After the exhibits were judged the club held a short business meet-

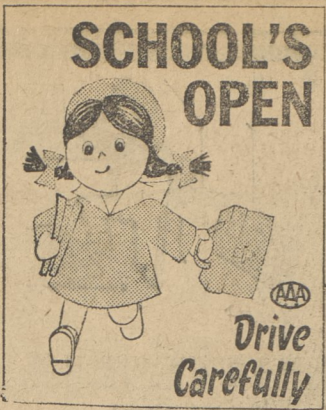
