

**Stephen Spender, Poet To Lecture At College**

Stephen Spender, English poet, literary critic, and editor of EN-COUNTER, will give a lecture at College Misericordia's Walsh Auditorium, Sunday evening, November 1. Mr. Spender will discuss WHAT IS MODERN IN MODERN ART.

As lecturer Stephen Spender is a well-known and highly respected figure at American universities. Since 1947, when he taught for a year at Sarah Lawrence College, he has frequently visited United States. He was Ellison Professor at the University of California in 1959. In 1962 he gave three public lectures at the Library of Congress on the Modern Imagination. In 1963 he was visiting lecturer in a modern poetry course at Northwestern University.

In 1962 Stephen Spender was made Commander of the British Empire, in the Honours List on the Queen's birthday. He was given Hon. D. Litt, at the University of Montpellier.

Mr. Spender was educated at University College School, London, and University College, Oxford. While at Oxford, he became the friend of W. H. Auden, who was also an undergraduate at that time. Later Auden, Cecil Day Lewis and Stephen Spender all published volumes of verse within a few years, and their works and names became associated in the public mind.

During World War II Stephen Spender was a fire fighter in the London National Fire Service. He also co-edited the Review HORIZON with Cyril Connolly from 1939-45. After the war, he travelled in Germany as a civilian military officer, and later he became counsellor in the section of letters in UNESCO.

**Marine L. Cpl. Faults On Steel Pike Operation**

Marine Lance Corporal William E. Faults, son of Mr. and Mrs. William H. Faults of Route 1, Noxen, has sailed from the east coast of the United States to take part in Operation STEEL PIKE in Spain. The combat training exercise will be the largest amphibious operation conducted in the Atlantic since World War II.

He is a member of Force Troops Atlantic, which is normally based at Camp Lejeune, N. C.

In the practice landing, 28,000 Marines of the Second Marine Division, Second Marine Aircraft Wing and Force Troops, Fleet Marine Force, Atlantic, along with a battalion of Spanish Marines will take part in a mock assault on beaches in Southern Spain on October 25 from landing craft and helicopters. The combined Marine Landing force will be carried and protected by a U. S. Spanish fleet of 94 vessels, including ships of the United States' Military Sea Transport Service and chartered ships of the U. S. merchant fleet.

Operation STEEL PIKE is being conducted to show the ability of U. S. and Allied amphibious forces to rapidly place large numbers of troops ashore and maintain them for as long as necessary. The operation will also train the forces of both countries in conducting joint operations.

Spanish Air Force units will fly missions in support of the landing force along with U. S. Navy and Marine aircraft operating from fast attack carriers and from the Marines short airfield for tactical support (SATS).

SATS is, in effect, a carrier flight deck, including catapults and arresting gear, moved ashore. It was developed by the Marine Corps to allow air units to go ashore quickly to support Marine ground forces in amphibious operations.

Most of the United States units taking part in operation STEEL PIKE will return to the U. S. during the first week in December.

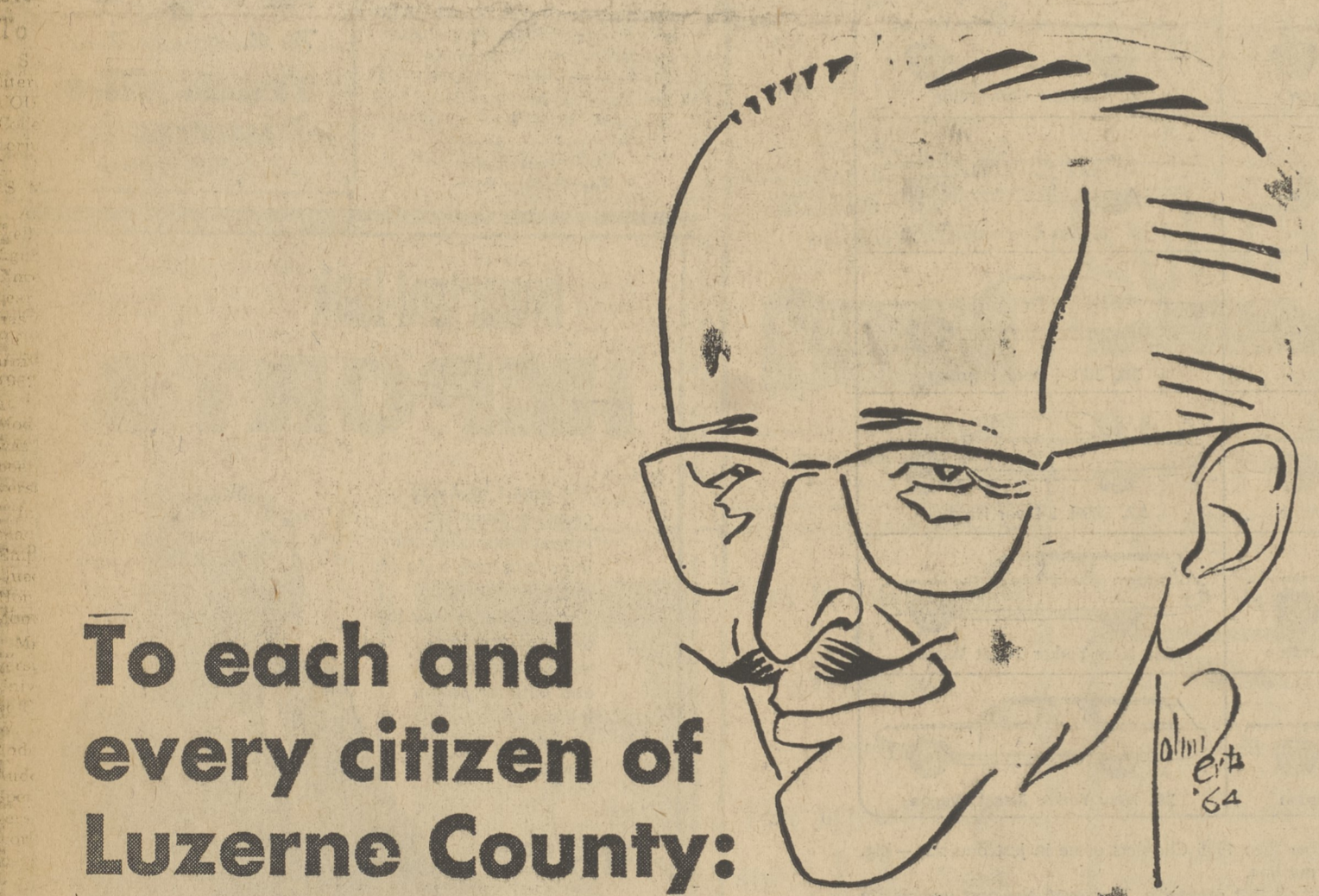
