Military Rites Held For Elmer Lamoreaux

Military services were held Monday afternoon at Norfolk, Va., for Alfred Lamoreaux, 73, formerly of Shavertown, who died suddenly Thursday afternoon of a heart attack.

Mr. Lamoreaux had been admitted to a Richmond Hospital for tests just a week previously. He had been disabled since World War I when he was severely injured in battle.

The son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Luther Lamoreaux, he had lived in Shavertown for a number of years before moving to Maryland five years ago, settling in Norfolk two years later.

Mr. Lamoreaux was a member of Black Diamond Post, American Legion, Kingston, and Willow Wood Presbyterian Church, Norfolk. While in this area he attended Shavertown Methodist Church.

He is survived by his wife, the former Anna Jarvis, of Maryland a sister Mrs. Marvin Yeast, Shavertown; a brother, Howard, Lindenhurst, N.Y., and a number of nieces and nephews.

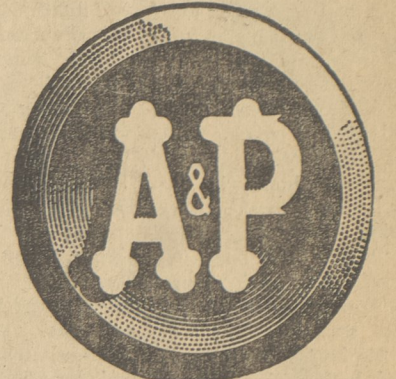
