ORDINANCE NO. 1
AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DALLAS, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, fixing the tax rate for the fiscal year 1965.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Dallas, Pa., Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1965 as follows:

Tax rate for general Borough purposes, the sum (11) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

For debt purpose, the sum of (1) mill on each dollar of assessed valuation.

Making a total tax rate for all Borough purposes of (12) mills.

Section 2. That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. 2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DALLAS, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, levying a per capita tax of five dollars for the calendar year 1965.

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED, pursuant to the authority of the act of June 25, 1947 (P.L. 1145) and its amendments, as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby levied a per capita tax of five dollars for each adult person who shall reside within the limits of Dallas Borough at any time during the calendar year 1965.

Section 2. All per capita taxes levied and assessed pursuant to this Ordinance shall become due and payable, shall be subject to the same discounts and penalties and shall be collected in accordance with the provision of the Act of May 25, 1945, (P.L. 1050).

ORDINANCE NO. 3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DALLAS, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, setting the salary of the TAX COLLECTOR of Dallas Borough.
