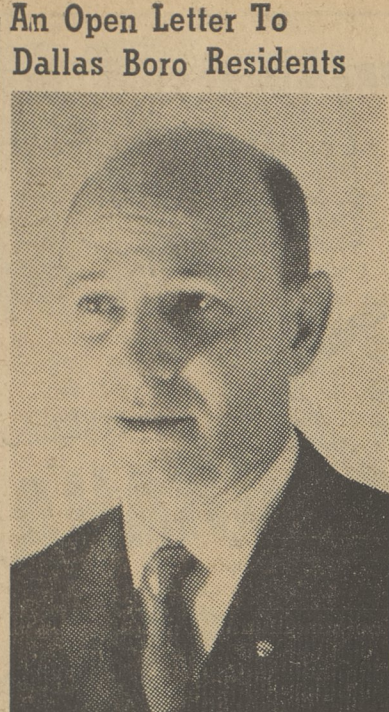

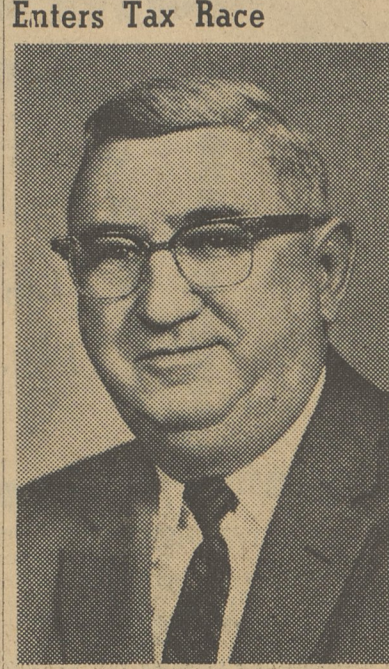
I remind you again, my name is fourth on the ballot and I respectfully solicit your vote.
