

Blaze At Asphalt Plant

A series of small explosions perforated the fire and smoke consuming two sheds at American Asphalt Company around 5, Friday afternoon.

Destroyed in this, the company's second fire in two weeks, were a repair shop, storage shed, and parts, drilling steel, old motors, tires, quarry vehicles, and other equipment. There were also electric and diesel motors being worked on.

Fire companies from Jackson, Trucksville, Shavertown, Dallas, Idetown, and Lake Silkworth responded, but not all were needed. Explosions were attributed to acetylene tanks and oil and grease tanks.
