

Everett L. Nicholson Is Named Head Of Scranton A&P Unit

Everett L. Nicholson has been named vice president in charge of the Scranton Unit of The Great Atlantic & Pacific Tea Company, it was announced today by William F. Leach, President of the Atlantic Division.

Mr. Nicholson, who was director of supermarket operations for the Division, succeeds George W. Koerber, who has been in charge of the Scranton Unit since 1960. Mr. Koerber was named vice president in charge of the Philadelphia Unit, replacing William T. Price, who became executive vice president of the Atlantic Division.

The new Scranton Unit head began his career with the nation's leading food retailer as a clerk in the Baltimore area in 1932 and within two years was promoted to store manager.

A native of Wilkes Barre, Mr. Davenport received his Bachelor of Arts Degree in Science, Latin, English and Social Science from Lafayette College, continuing graduate work at Pennsylvania State University, New York University and the University of Pennsylvania.

He taught in the Wilkes Barre District Schools for six years and served as a psychologist in the guidance department for two years before going to Carbon County. He accepted a position there in 1941 as supervisor of special education leaving a year later for four years service in the Army during World War II as a personnel consultant with the Auditor General's Department.

Mr. Davenport's new appointment was announced by George W. Hoffman, acting superintendent of the State Department of Public Instruction. He succeeds Stuart E. Prutzman. The new school head is married to the former Ruth B. Howell, daughter of the late Dr. and Mrs. G. L. Howell, Trucksville. The couple are the parents of two children, Robert, a sophomore at Michigan State University and Alice Ruth, in 7th grade at Lehighton Area Schools. 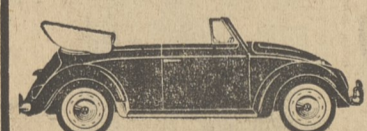

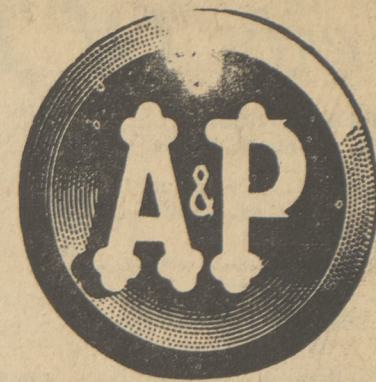
