Army Pfc Robert T. Tupper, son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert E. Tupper, 597 Sago Street, Dallas, is presently serving in the Republic of Korea with Headquarters Battery, 6th Missile Battalion (HAWK), 44th Artillery of the 38th Brigade (AD).

The organization of which Pfc Tupper is a member is a HAWK Missile Air Defense Battalion serving as a component of the United Nations Forces in Korea.

The primary mission of the Hawk missile system is to destroy low flying aircraft which might slip under normal radar protection.

Pay Specialist is Pfc Tupper's Army job while serving with the 6th Missile Battalion (HAWK), 44th Artillery. Prior to overseas movement he was assigned to the Pay Specialist School, Fort Benjamin Harrison, Indiana.

Pfc Tupper graduated from Dallas Senior High School in 1963. Before entering the Army in 1964, he was employed by Pioneer Manufacturing Company.
