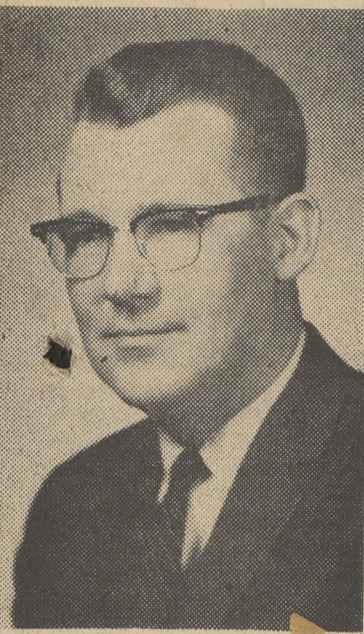


Booster Club Chairman

NOTICE

DALLAS SCHOOL DISTRICT EARNED INCOME TAX

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of School Directors of Dallas School District intend to enact a resolution imposing a tax of one-half per cent (1/2%) on the total earned income of residents of Dallas School District (Dallas Borough, Dallas Township, Franklin Township and Kingston Township), effective July 3, 1967, pursuant to The Local Tax Enabling Act approved December 31, 1965 (Act No. 511 of 1965). In the judgment of the Board of School Directors, the imposition of said tax is necessitated by (1) the increased salaries of employees, (2) the general increased costs of operating the schools, (3) the additional rentals for new building facilities due to the increase in population and (4) the avoidance of an increased tax burden on real estate in the school district. The amount of revenue estimated to be derived from said tax is \$86,000,000 for the fiscal year 1967-68 and for each fiscal year thereafter during which said tax may be continued in effect.

A Regular Meeting at which the enacting of such resolution will be considered will be held at the Library of Dallas Senior High School, Dallas, Pennsylvania, on Tuesday, May 9, 1967, at 8:00 p.m., E.D.S.T. If such resolution is not adopted at said meeting, action may be taken at any regular or adjourned meeting or a Special Meeting called for said purpose.

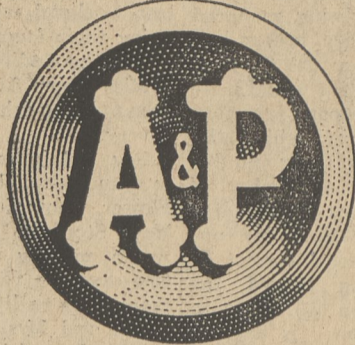
