Headed for a deep camp far back in the timber or up in the high country? Don't skimp on the warm clothing and blankets you lug along! True, you want to travel light, but don't travel so light you find efforts to avoid discomfort or exhaustion taking chances in your posture because of a sudden storm or extra cold snap.

The quickest way to warm up a cold camper is to turn on the gas oven for a few minutes, you say? Yeah! It's a quick way to the morgue, too. Since the oven is insulated, you'll have to leave the oven door partly open to get some of the heat generated. Even though the oven is vented, deadly carbon monoxide will accompany some of the heat into your little camper room.

The gas — which is so insidious because it is odorless, tasteless and colorless — is so toxic that less than 100 parts per million will bring on symptoms of carbon monoxide poisoning.

Or maybe you're in a cold, damp tent, shivering under too few blankets or in too tight a sleeping bag. Why not do like the Indians did? . . . build yourself a small fire! Better yet, heat up a small pile of those charcoal briquettes you brought along. There are quicker ways to commit suicide but none purer!

Modern tents of light-woven materials with their built in floors, exterior frames and zippered doors and windows are a far cry from the vented tepees of the Indians. First symptom of carbon monoxide poisoning is a headache which grows in intensity. This may be followed by nausea and vomiting.
