ing the services and fulfilling the needs of those who can not provide for themselves. Through increased automation and consolidation of activities and elimination of duplication, there can be a continuation of increased salaries and services and, equally as important, bring about measurable economy that could decrease the need for additional taxation.

It is my opinion, Area Enemy No. 1 is beautification. The primary objective of the next administration should be to rid the cities, urban, and rural areas of stripping pits, junk yards, and abandon junk and debris along the highways of our beautiful country-side.

ECONOMIC ENEMY NO. 1 is the hodge-podge of individual municipalities providing totally inadequate, terribly expensive, politically influenced, services. A concentrated drive by a research task force should be initiated by the county government to report the full impact consolidation of the 72 political sub-divisions would have on our economic conditions, improved public services, and our national standing.

By 1970, a new federal census will be taken and this area's future could be seriously affected by the action or the lack of action we undertake today.

Area Gets Prevue Of Postal Rates Due To Go Into Effect January 7th

Increased rates for all classes of mail except parcel post and international mail will go into effect January 7. Postmaster Edward Buckley reminded postal customers today.

"Even with the new rates of six cents for first-class mail and 10 cents for air mail, postal service is still a real bargain," Postmaster Buckley declared. "For six cents you can send a letter to any of the 50 states, to any United States territory or possession, to Canada, or Mexico, or to an American Serviceman stationed anywhere in the World."

Postmaster Buckley pointed out that the new rate for post cards will be five cents and for airmail post cards eight cents.

He said the added cent in the letter rate is a 20 per cent increase compared to a 24 per cent boost in the rates for mailing newspapers and magazines and a 34 per cent hike for advertising circulars, "Occupant" mail, and other materials in the third class category.

The new rate of six cents per ounce for first-class mail applies up to 13 ounces and the new rate of 10 cents per ounce for air mail applies up to 7 ounces. Under the new rate structure all first-class mail over 13 ounces and all air mail over 7 ounces will be merged into a single category.

These heavier pieces of first-class and air mail subject to the single rate schedule will be delivered by the fastest available means of transportation.

A flat rate of 80 cents will be charged for all mail in this category up to one pound. For all mail weighing more than one pound, the present air parcel post rates will continue to apply, except that the postage one matter weighing between one and five pounds will change at half-pound intervals rather than one pound intervals.

Postmaster Buckley said that the new rate structure will mean a reduction of postage on some parcels.

Another rate change that will affect the general public is the increase from four to six cents for the first two ounces of individual pieces of third class mail. Unsealed greetings cards may be sent at this rate.

He emphasized that the new rate on unsealed greetings cards will not go into effect until January 7 and until then they can be mailed at the old rate of four cents.

He also noted that effective January 7 special handling will be available on third-class parcels weighing between eight and sixteen ounces. Special handling has not been available on these parcels since 1958, when packages weighing eight and sixteen ounces were transferred from fourth to third-class mail.

There will be no changes in the charges for special delivery, special handling, registered mail, certified mail, cash on delivery or insurance.

"We have a supply of one-cent stamps on hand," for those people who have five-cent stamps and need one-cent stamps to make up the postage required under the new rates.

Higher rates also will go into effect January 7 for all categories of second class mail, bulk rate third class mail, controlled circulation mail, and the educational materials category of fourth-class mail.

Mailers using these classes who need information on the new rates should contact the local Post Offices.
